## Garden Corner

Did you ever wonder why some gardens are beautiful and naturally draw your eye while others look like a chaotic mess? This often happens when there are too many shapes and sizes, colors or textures with little regard for simple design or repeating patterns.

Repetition in the garden is the way to create consistency and structure between shapes, balance and color.



Repetition doesn't have to be the same plant. You can use similar colors, overall shape or textures. Repeat in various places within your garden or pick two or three plants of the same color or similar texture and place in different places. Select plants that bloom in different seasons throughout the landscape so that something is always blooming in your yard. This can be challenging. Don't go crazy with lots of color because this can cause chaos. Choose colors carefully repeating around the flower bed. Complement the green foliage with a few repetitions of plants with variegated leaves. When you plant use odd numbers, 3, 5, 7, 9 etc. since they appear more natural and pleasing to the eye. If you wish for a more formal garden, then go with even number of plantings.

Shape also helps in repeat gardening. You can plant rounded plants, shrubs of the same shape or upright lines of trees or flowers. You can also do this with pots of like shape and color. If you have a red door, for example, you can repeat this color in your garden to complement your door. Also, if you have a brick home you can pick this brick up in your garden by using brick planters or plants with reddish brown foliage. Like in the picture above you see many impatiens planted throughout the planting beds which give this garden consistency and just a touch of color. These plants complement the Japanese maple pictured as well as several larger reddish colored plants. Gardening should not be a chore. Make it fun and share it with your children/grandchildren/spouse/partner.

**March Gardening tip:** Plant summer squash, tomatoes, more beans (to keep extend the harvest season), beets, melons etc. Fertilize trees and shrubs Trim Bougainvillea. Prune dead wood or frost damage in early Feb.- March. Remove offshoots or vigorous growth as needed. Spring to fall flowering Lantana: Can be cut to ground in March to remove frost-damaged wood. Prune during growing season to control shape.
